year, by the end of June, we're going to lose a million and a half dollars and this isn't a new project, this isn't a project that just sprung up overnight. This is a project that this Legislature started in 1979 to establish an art collection for this state and the City of Kearney has pumped in about an equal amount of its own money just to pump up and help try to keep a state project surviving, even though it's located in their own community. But what we're looking at now is preserving a treasure of the state and that's the Museum of Nebraska Art and without your help we won't be able to do that. And, with that, I would ask for your vote and your approval of this request for 395,000. Thank you.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The question before the house is the adoption of the Kristensen amendment to LB 1031. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Kristensen's amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Schellpeper. (The Schellpeper amendment appears on page 1379 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: The Chair recognizes Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members, if you all recall, I think it's been four years ago, I had a bill that established the Commission for Antique Farm Machinery and when we did that we did not put any appropriation into it for the funding of it. Consequently, up to this date they have not met. It's been four years and they have not met because they didn't have any money to pay the expenses of the commission. Well, the \$5,000, part of it is for their expenses and the rest of it will be to use a building on the East Campus out at the university. They have a building out there that they will let the Antique Commission use but they have to put in a larger door so they can get this machinery into this building. The university has said you can use this building but you have to put in your own door and so half of the money would go for putting in this door and the other half would be to pay the expenses of this Antique Commission so that they can have some
