SENATOR WEIHING: Sure, I'll do that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Morrissey, will you?

SENATOR MORRISSEY: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, see, case closed. But I'm going to support Senator Schellpeper. Senator Scott Moore, will you?

SENATOR MOORE: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm going to give my \$100. We've got 400...we've got \$500 already. All right.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Hefner. The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. Shall debate now cease? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Shall debate cease? Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Debate ceases. Senator Schellpeper, would you like to close?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members, it's kind of amusing, I guess. We spent probably 40 minutes here talking about \$5,000 and we have several bills that deal with several hundred thousand dollars that take five minutes. But I think this is a very important \$5,000 for this commission. If anyone would want to come out to the fairgrounds during the fair, there is about 150 tractors out there, Senator Chambers, that are steam engines and all the way up to fairly...about 30-year-old tractors, but there's all type of tractors out there and it's really a very impressive display. It seems like we are not doing enough to restore these implements and to take care of our heritage and so I think this money, although it isn't very much, it's enough to get this commission to come together, to meet, to put some implements inside of this building. It's a way that we can look at our past our children can look at it and say, well, that's what you actually farmed with years ago, and people did and they were successful and that's why we need to preserve it. So I would just urge that you support the \$5,000. Senator Wehrbein and also Senator Chambers would like to have some of my time, Mr. Speaker.
