

lawyers' and attorneys' fees, so that is what can happen. But I can tell you, Senator Haberman, exactly where to get the money, and I will offer the amendment, and that is to take it out of the NCCY budget of Social Services. I know that Senator Wesely must not have been listening there, but I happened to receive some information just last week, 198 families served, and they are still looking to expand their program in that area to utilize the staff and to utilize the buildings and so on, and they have Whitehall that maybe they will do it. They are thinking about taking in some child care and advice, but stop and think of it, folks, 198 families served last year and some of that is family consultation only, and then they are talking of opening up a home in Columbus, Nebraska, some of it 24 hour a day, seven day a week coverage. I am having an awful time, I can't in my mind see how that they can expand in that area when outstate or in God's country, or whatever you want to call it, we probably serve 198 families in one week, and how that that can be justified, and then we have to come in here and ask for 50,000 or 40,000 or 100,000 to again study the social services. I know there is a lot of work there to be done, but I guess they probably wouldn't give us any money to study their own problems, but there are problems out there and we simply cannot continue to let that type of abuse or waste of money to continue.
