PRESIDENT: LB 965 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 1032, with the emergency clause attached.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1032 on Final Reading.)

All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1032 pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1414 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 46 ayes, 0 mays, 1 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 1032 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 1236, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1236 on Final Reading.)

All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1236 pass? those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1415 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 46 ayes, 0 mays, 1 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

LB 1236 passes. It's my understanding we're jumping over LB 571, going to LB 656.

Mr. President, with respect to LB 656, the first order of business, Senator Nelson, you had an amendment printed, Senator. I understand you wish to withdraw that amendment, is that correct?

SENATOR NELSON: Correct.

PRESIDENT: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Nelson would move to return the bill for a specific amendment. (Nelson amendment appears on pages 1415-16 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Nelson, please.
