PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Microphone not on)...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We have with us today as our Chaplain of the day, Pastor George Cook of the Fellowship Community Church in Lincoln. Would you please rise for the invocation.
