SENATOR WARNER: Well, there is a very limited program. As I recall, it is by complaint, I think.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, I would support this amendment. I recall now this issue quite a bit better, and we were having a lot of complaints about problems with our gasoline and the quality of it, and I haven't heard much lately. I hope that program we put in place is doing something about it, but if we have this other activity going on, we certainly need to look into it. So I would support the warner amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Senator Schmit. Thank you. Any other discussion? Senator Warner, would you like to close? Senator Warner waives off and the question is the adoption of the Warner amendment to 1031. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, please.
