

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Shall the house go under call? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 17 ayes, 1 nay to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The house is under call. Members, return to your desks and record your presence. Those members outside the Chambers, please return and check in. The house is under call. Sergeant-at-Arms, please come forward. Senator Lowell Johnson, please. Senator Byars. Senator Kristensen, please check in. Senator Smith. Senator Dierks. Senator Chambers, record your presence. Senator Nelson, please. Senator Robak. Senators Moore, Haberman, Schellpeper, the house is under call. Senator Schellpeper, please, the house is under call. Members, return to your seats. A roll call vote has been requested. The question, of course, is the adoption of the Lynch amendment to LB 315. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote read. See pages 1587-88 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 28 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment is adopted. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment that I have is from Senator Hefner. Senator Hefner is excused.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Is anyone prepared to handle the Hefner amendment? I think not, Senator Morrissey. The next amendment, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have is from Senator Chambers.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I want to withdraw that.

SPEAKER BARRETT: It's withdrawn.
