

Legislature, may I inquire of the Clerk for all of our benefits to indicate to the body what motions are filed on LB 688? Mr. Chair, could I ask for that to be done?

SPEAKER BARRETT: I think that would be appropriate.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. If the Clerk would read for us all the motions which are filed on LB 688.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first motion I have to the bill is a motion to return by Senator Landis. Would you like me to read the amendment, Senator, or is that...

SENATOR LANDIS: That is the one on abortion referral?

CLERK: That is the one that talks about staff person utilize the authority to section, child care provider must have a on file Department of Health statement declaring the provider does not engage in abortion referral or counseling.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you.

CLERK: That is your first motion. Your second motion, Senator, again, by Senator Landis, is to return the bill for amendment that requires the curriculum shall not include any instruction on contraception counselling, contraception or contraception counseling. Your third motion to return, Senator, again offered by yourself, is a motion to return to require that the curriculum shall not include any material on abortion counseling. I then, Mr. President, have a motion from Senator Labeledz to suspend the germaneness rule to permit consideration of her amendment, AM2892. It's a rather lengthy amendment. I'm not sure what it is. I suspect it's...Senator Labeledz could best characterize it quicker than I could, Senator. Then I have two suspension motions, Senator, with respect to voting on the bill after that amendment is adopted and readvancing.

SENATOR LANDIS: There's a motion to readvance, to suspend the rules and to readvance without further debate and amendment, is that right?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR LANDIS: And then there's a second suspension motion and that suspension motion is what?
