Others just keep chugging right along, just keep going, the little engine that could, and that's the way some of us are. I say this for those who say that they are what's called pro-life. They are persistent, they are determined and they are seeking to find stratagems in the rules that they can use to achieve their purpose. We are different sides of the coin. Manes was a king and he believed in a division in the world between good and evil. These two forces are constantly fighting against each other, Manichaeanism, and when you have on one side those who say they want a woman to have no right to an abortion and those on the other side saying we think she should have that right, you have a Manichaean syndrome or circumstance as to which is good and which is evil. It depends on who is speaking because as one of those fellows, Ralph Waldo Emerson or his friend, Henry David Thoreau said, these words can be attached to any subject that we want to attach them to. So, I think our position is right. I think our position is good. I will not say the others' position is evil, I will not say that it is bad. I will say that they are sincere people, but they are sincerely wrong. They are sincerely mistaken and the level of sincerity does not add one whit to the rightness of a person's position or cause. I will always have to do more on behalf of those who are persons in being than I do for those who may be persons or who are persons potentially. Women are the bone in this dog fight. Each side is using women to try to make a point and the women are not receiving the consideration they are entitled to considering the serious circumstances that they are facing. So until we run out of time here today, and that's only eight more hours...well seven hours and fifty-three minutes, I plan to be here and I plan to participate and I assure you that we have within the rules the means to stay here for seven hours and fifty-three minutes and I will be here, I will participate and I will continue to push for the right of a woman to make this unique personal, very serious choice without any interference by or...
