the hybrid board, and I can even buy into them, but I think it's a pretty major thing that this bill is trying to do in making those regents, at least almost half of them, appointed. So I guess I feel about this issue that we need more discussion of it. I feel the same way about the bill. I think it's a major change. I, personally, would hope that we would not act on this bill this year, that we would give it some more time, we would get more input, more public attitude testing and that we would maybe come back again next year and address this issue again. With that, I am going to remove the amendment, please.

PRESIDENT: By that do you mean you're withdrawing it?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Withdraw.

PRESIDENT: Okay, it is withdrawn. Do you have anything on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have to the resolution is by Senator McFarland. Senator, this is your amendment 3011. It is found on page 1372 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator McFarland, please.

SENATOR McFARLAND: Withdraw that amendment, Mr. Clerk.

PRESIDENT: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, anything else?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, the next motion on the resolution, Senator McFarland, is your AM3010, Senator. It is also on page 1372.

PRESIDENT: Senator McFarland.

SENATOR McFARLAND: This is 3011?

CLERK: 3010. It's the one you had labeled number two, Senator.

SENATOR McFARLAND: Number two, I see. I'll withdraw that as well.

PRESIDENT: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment is by Senator Warner. Senator, this is your amendment on page 1381 of the Journal.
