responsibilities that they should have. For instance, the...

PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR WITHEM: ...University of Nebraska at Lincoln is designated as the primary doctoral granting institution in the State of Nebraska, and state colleges have regional responsibilities, service responsibilities. See, you and I now both have the books on our desks so...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Hannibal just brought me the statutes that mention a number of specific things, but what I'm looking for are the terms to see if they are the same now so that if we're discussing one idea that is existing in the statute but we use different language in the Constitution, then the two are not the same. And I want to know, for the purpose of this discussion, in case my amendment fails, whether "primary service responsibilities" means the same thing as "primary service areas".

PRESIDENT: Time. Senator Lamb, please.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members, earlier this afternoon when we got on this subject I had this language that Senator Chambers is talking about outlined in my book, which I showed to Senator Lynch sitting here and asking him what that meant, and so I'd just like to continue some of the questioning that Senator Chambers has started. You know, I don't know...well, maybe, Senator Conway, could I ask you a question?

PRESIDENT: Senator Conway, please.

SENATOR LAMB: This sentence that we're talking about, it says, "The Legislature may provide that appointed members of each board of trustees shall be appointed from the areas of the state which are consistent with the institution's primary service responsibilities." What would you say is the area of the state which constitutes Wayne State College's primary service responsibility?

SENATOR CONWAY: Given...Senator Lamb, given the current structure of the four state institutions, they have, amongst themselves but being under common board, have somewhat carved up the state. I believe Wayne State College has about 22 counties in the northeast and north central regions of the state that are
