Therefore, they're willing to do almost anything to salvage it. I didn't do that intimidating act. Why I am as nice and gentle a fellow as you could ever meet and you know it. Watch it, Chizek. While I am up here, see, I could tell on...well, I wouldn't be telling on Senator Chizek but he gets breaks from the State Patrol that I don't get, and I know that for a fact. So, there are different ways that people do things. There are different reactions to those people. But regardless of any reaction that anybody has to me, I am going to continue to conduct my legislative business in the way that I see fit. As long as these types of motions are brought, I will oppose them. And, Senator Schmit, you didn't hear me say I am going to support Senator Barrett's motion. I am going to oppose it because I have an amendment, in fact, I have two amendments on one bill, and I have one to try to kill that bill to put those two unnecessary judges...

You all miss those things. I don't. What Senator Schmit fails to see is that we are not going to vote individually on these bills
