CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Debate ceases. Senator Labeledz, would you like to close?

SENATOR LABEDZ: No closing. Just move for the advancement or the approval of the motion. Thank you.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The motion before the house is to suspend the rules and move the nine bills to Select File from General File. That is the question before the body. Those in favor of that motion, please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Looks like we're going to have to have a call of the house and take call in votes.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Call of the house has been requested. All in
