they get advanced over to Select File, would fall behind the bills that we advance this morning, many of which are rather controversial and I think would more than eat up the few hours that we'll have tomorrow to debate them. With that, Mr. Speaker, I would answer any questions that folks might have. Otherwise, I would ask for the 30 votes to overrule the agenda so that we can get as much work done tonight as possible.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you, Senator Hall. Discussion on the Hall motion? Senator Wesely followed by Senators Chambers and Withem.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I would rise in support of the Hall motion. I strongly agree with him. I think any time spent going back to the remaining committee priority bills on General File will be time wasted. They'll follow the other bills that we advanced this morning. Those other bills will obviously take more time than we have even tomorrow. They'll never see the light of day. Any time spent whatsoever on them will be time wasted. We need to get back to Select File, work out some problems there, deal with those issues and get that taken care of. Tomorrow is our last day to do that. I think we need to begin that work tonight. We'll never even get through what's on Select File as it stands right now. clearly I don't see any way that we should not support this, that we should in fact support the Hall amendment and go on to Select File. That's where we need to put the work in in the remaining hours that we have left today and tomorrow.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Withem, please.

SENATOR WITHEM: Mr. Speaker, I'll try not to be a broken record. My guess is looking at the agenda when it was put together the assumption was we were going to spend a great deal of time with the General File priority bills, individual senator priority bills, that Item 8 on our agenda was anticipated taking quite a bit of time. Obviously we don't have to do that now. I do think if we advance any of these bills from General File over to Select File they'll fall in behind the Select File bills that...the General File bills that already went over to Select this morning. We'll probably never get to them. We're probably better spent using our time in the manner Senator Hall is suggesting so I would urge our doing that. It's not that I have any strong vested interest in any of the bills other than Senator Hannibal's plumbing board bill I think is a critically
