SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Senator Korshoj.

SENATOR KORSHOJ: Question.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Korshoj moves the previous question. Five hands I do see. Shall debate now cease? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Debate ceases. Senator Ashford, will you close?

SENATOR ASHFORD: I just move the question, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The question is the reconsideration of the vote on domestic violence and ADC. Those in favor of reconsidering please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to reconsider.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Motion prevails. We are reconsidering. Senator Ashford, please.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Mr. Speaker, I would believe that this matter has been discussed thoroughly and I would just ask the body to reconsider its prior vote and override the veto. Thank you.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Any discussion? Senator Labeledz, your light is still on.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Just very briefly, Mr. President. Senator Hall mentioned the fact that his priority was set. Mine, I told you this morning, was set. Number one was aging and number two was ADC. So I'd urge the members to override the veto.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The question is, shall the veto be overridden on the matter of domestic violence and ADC previously offered by Senators Ashford and Crosby. All in favor please
