SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Senator Langford, followed by Senator Korshoj. Senator Langford. The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. Shall debate now close? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Debate ceases. Senator Schmit, would you care to close?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I will be very brief. I appreciate Senator Schimek's support of the motion. I have explained it already. I believe it is, as I said earlier, it is a very small amount of money, but I believe it is also very important that we acknowledge our responsibility to the non-Indian students in northeast Nebraska and that we vote this \$24,000 for that institution in that part of the state.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The question is, shall the gubernatorial veto be overridden as offered by Senator Schmit? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, could we have a roll call vote, please.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Roll call vote has been requested. Members, return to your seat.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Could we have the members check in please.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Certainly. Members, please check in. Senator Wesely, Senator Landis, Senator Schmit, Senator Goodrich. Senators Goodrich and Hannibal, would you please record your presence. May we proceed, Senator Schmit? Thank you. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2029 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Motion fails. Next motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion is by Senator Chizek.
