PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Attention, Senators, the Ninety-First Legislature Special Session will convene in five minutes. (Gavel.) Ladies and gentlemen, if I could have your attention a moment, please, we'll start in with the festivities of the day. If you would remain standing, we'll ask Senator Lowell Johnson to come to the podium and offer invocation. Senator Johnson.
