Mr. President, I have also received from the Highway Safety Division, the Nebraska Department of Roads, their annual report with respect to Traffic Accident Facts; a report from the Nebraska Energy Office regarding the Central Interstate Compact Low-level Radioactive Waste Disposal Facility; a report from the Auditor of Public Accounts regarding an audit by the Department of Revenue, the State Auditor's Office; a report from the Department of Administrative Services Central Data Processing Division; the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority has offered a report; Department of Labor; the Nebraska Department of Social Services; the Natural Resources Commission; the Nebraska State Historical Society; the Department of Administrative Services annual report; the Department of Economic Development's annual report; the Nebraska Indian Commission five-year plan; the report prepared by the Natural Resources Commission pursuant to statute; the Nebraska Energy Office offers another report pursuant to LB 727; Telecommunications Division; the Nebraska Educational TV; report from the University of Nebraska pursuant to LB 813; report from the Papio Natural Resources District regarding payment of attorney fees, that is filed pursuant to statute; the Middle-Missouri NRD. Mr. President, I have in addition to those reports received communications from the State of Iowa on action taken by the State Legislature on a resolution offered there, as well as a resolution adopted by the Texas Legislature and forwarded on to Nebraska for their consideration.

Finally, Mr. President, I have an appointment letter from the Secretary of State with respect to an appointment to the Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission. That, too, will be referred to Reference Committee. That is all that I have, Mr. President.
