the question and you have handed out to you what that division is, Sections 1, 2, 3, 8, 9, 10, and 13 which deal with the issue of the classification of certain personal property and then separate would be Sections 4, 5, 6 and 11 which dealt with the sales tax issue, and Sections 7 and 12 which deal with the income tax issue. I believe these are separate and distinct and can be divided and dealt with separately and, as a matter of fact, it would, I'm sure, be more workable to discuss it in that way. So I would ask for a ruling of the Chair to divide the question on that basis.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, as I understand it, you want first Sections 1, 2, 3, 8, 9, 10, and 13, right? And the second division, 4, 5, 6, and 11. The third one, 7, and 12. I would rule that those divisions are okay. Senator Hall, I will call on you. I understand you wish to change that a little bit.

SENATOR HALL: Well, Mr. President, I would just ask Senator Warner a question if he would. And the only reason...and I apologize for not, Senator Warner, doing this prior but I just now thought of it. But would you consider separating Sections 2 and 3 as a separate division that we could deal with separately? Because I do see those as the substantive issues in the original draft of the bill that were changed by the committee amendments. If not, I understand and I don't have a problem with it but I just think that I can...I don't think there is any problems with 1, 8, 9, 10 and 13 or the other sections as you have them divided out. If not, that's fine.

SENATOR WARNER: Could I ask...Section 2, you're dealing with...Section 3, I have no problem, in fact, my amendment up there, the first one, deals with Section 3 and I don't have any problem with separating that issue out or striking Section 3 as far as that goes. But I don't know...I don't recall what Section 2 in the committee...

SENATOR HALL: Section 2 is the sunset. And the reason I think you have 8, 9, 10, and 13 in it is because they all reflect that provision. And I don't think...

SENATOR WARNER: I have...I am not sure where to do this in the amendment up there, Senator, so that it's clear but I don't have any problem with it.

SENATOR HALL: That's fine. Why don't we go about it...
