PRESIDENT: All right. Then this is the way it is, gentlemen. Correct me if I'm wrong or right. In the first section we have 1, 2, 8, 9, 10 and 13. Is that correct? The second section is 4, 5, 6 and 11. The third one is 7 and 12, and the fourth one is number 3. Is that...and you want to do number 3 first, is that correct? Senator Warner, is that agreeable with you?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, that's okay.

PRESIDENT: We'll do number 3 first then.

SENATOR WARNER: We're doing...we're striking Section 3, is the first argument?

PRESIDENT: Yes, correct. And we'll go ...

SENATOR WARNER: Because the way this...Mr. President, if I can...the way the amendment is drafted there are other provisions that are necessary in amendment number one. So the only thing we would be dealing with is, I believe...well, it's all right, let's just deal with number one. I can handle it that way.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall will deal with Section 1, to start with. Is that all right? And that includes 1, 2, 8, 9, 10 and 13. Correct? We're leaving 2 in that section. All right, Senator Hall, are you going to begin the discussion on this, or is Senator Warner?

SENATOR HALL: I might as well.

PRESIDENT: Okay.

SENATOR HALL: He has asked that they divide it...to be divided and dealt with separately, I don't...

PRESIDENT: Okay. All right, members of the Legislature, so that you will know what we're doing, you have had handed out LB 7 committee amendments and then it shows, one, Sections 1, 2, 3, 8, 9, 10 and 13, and we're taking number 3 out of that section and leaving it by itself and that forms section number 4. The other sections remain the same as shown on this piece of paper. So, at the moment, we are taking, number one, which includes Sections 1, 2, 8, 9, 10 and 13. Are there any questions about that?
