PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: If the members of the Legislature will please take their seats and take their family members with them, close to them, we will start in a few moments. Those of you on the sidelines, please take seats if there are some there. There are some seats in the balcony if there are not enough to accommodate you all. (Gavel.)
