If not, all those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted. Move on to appointment of temporary officers. Senator Hefner, please.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I move that we appoint Mr. Patrick J. O'Donnell as temporary Clerk of the Legislature and Mr. Karl Kamprath as temporary Sergeant at Arms.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is approved. Resignation and appointment letters, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have received a resignation letter from Speaker William Barrett effective December 15. Pursuant to his resignation, Governor Orr appointed Mr. Edward Schrock as a member for the 39th Legislative District. I have in my possession the appointment letter as well as the certificate of oath and the appropriation communications from the Secretary of State's Office.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: Move on to the Committee on Credentials, Chairman of the Executive Board, Senator Labedz, please, the Committee on Credentials.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President. I move that we proceed to the election of five persons to serve as the Committee on Credentials who will forthwith report to the Legislature on the credentials of those claiming to be elected to the Legislature in the general election in November, 1990.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: Senator Schmit, your light is on, did you wish to discuss this, please? If there is no further discussion, the question is the adoption of the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted. Senator Labedz, would you please tell us who the nominations are.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Yes, thank you, Mr. President. I move to elect the five senior members of the Legislature to serve as the Committee on Credentials.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: Are there any further nominations from the floor? Okay, if not, Senator Labedz, would you make the motion, please, to close and adopt the five members you have mentioned.
