SENATOR HARTNETT: I move to proceed to the election of the six other members of the Executive Board of the Legislative Council as outlined in Section 50-401.01.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is carried. Will the caucuses please report their findings to the Clerk. If they have not met, please do meet at this time. Mr. Clerk, do you have the reports?

CLERK: Mr. President, from the first caucus Senators Schimek and Wehrbein have been selected to serve on the Executive Board; from the second caucus Senators Chambers and Hall; and from the third Senators Hefner and Haberman.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: Senator Lindsay, please, on the motion.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I move the approval of the nominees to the Executive Board of the Legislative Council.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: Thank you. You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted, it is adopted and these folks that have been mentioned are elected to the Executive Board. Congratulations to all of you. Senator Haberman, please.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, I move to proceed to the election of the Standing Committee Chairperson, by secret ballot, in accordance with Rule 3, Section 7.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: Thank you. You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is carried. We will start, of course, with agriculture, Committee on Agriculture. Senator Schellpeper, please.
