CLERK:    29 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 1.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    LB 1 is now advanced to E & R.    Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:    Madam President, LB 2, introduced by the Executive Board. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10, referred directly to General File.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Okay, I recognize Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER:    Madam President, members of the Legislature, as indicated by the title, this merely changes reference to federal agencies in the statutes who's names have been changed since those bills were introduced and enacted. It reflects the proper name for those agencies now. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Thank you, Senator Warner. Senator Warner, do you have a closing statement? Okay. We will proceed with a vote. All those in favor to advance LB 2 to E & R, please vote aye, opposed please vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record the vote.

CLERK:    32 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 2.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Okay, the motion passes and LB 2 is advanced to E & R.    Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:    Madam President, LB 3, introduced by Senator Labeledz. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10, referred directly to General File

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Recognize Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER:    Madam President, members of the Legislature, this, as indicated by title, affects public power districts. It will clarify whether conflicting...conflicts between different sections as to president, chairperson, general manager, some of those changes then would indicate chief executive officer, but it will, in effect, remove any of those areas where there may be omissions in a following sentence...section and/or reflect a chief executive officer as opposed to a general manager, and make it uniform for all sections.
