

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, this deals with the State Highway Commission, legislation enacted in 1987. As I recall, it was when we went from seven to eight districts. That may not be correct, but in any event a portion of Cass County was not... was omitted from the draft, and the bill changes those descriptions so that the entire part of the county are included in the appropriate district. I would move the bill be advanced, and would waive any closing.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. We'll now proceed with the vote on the motion to advance. Oh, I'm sorry. Senator Wehrbein, I recognize you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. President and members, I think I ought to support this seeing how I heard a magic work there. That's all I wanted to say.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. We will now proceed with the vote on the motion to advance LB 5. All those in favor please vote aye, all those opposed please vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement LB 5.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion to advance passes, and LB 5 is advanced to E & R. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 6, introduced by the Chair of the Executive Board. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10, referred directly to General File.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, as you see it changes references in the statute that refer to four state colleges to read "three", which reflects the change in Kearney State College to becoming a part of the university. I would move that the bill be advanced and waive any closing.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Seeing no requests for debate, we will proceed with a vote on the motion to advance LB 6 to E & R. All those in favor please vote aye, all those opposed please vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record the vote.
