PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. I'll now recognize Senator Lamb followed by Senator Nelson. Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Madam Chair and members, I have a question for Senator Baack, please.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes.

SENATOR LAMB: I know...is this an annual fee or just a one time fee? I know...I think you said it was an annual fee, but I note on the fiscal note by the Department of Motor Vehicles down there about halfway down the page it says, the fee indicated in the bill provides for an application fee initially of \$10 with no renewal fee, so I'm trying to sort that out.

SPEAKER BAACK: My understanding is at the hearing that day, the man from the Department of Motor Vehicles testified at the hearing that day, and they are interpreting that to mean a yearly fee.

SENATOR LAMB: A yearly fee?

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes.

SENATOR LAMB: Although...then it would...that's not correct where it says no renewal fee? Is that an incorrect statement on the fiscal note?

SPEAKER BAACK: Right, I think we need to...and that's possibly something that we need to correct, I think, because I think it needs to be on a yearly basis that they need to do that. I think they should have to pay that fee on a yearly basis and he did testify to that, that that was their interpretation that it was a yearly renewal.

SENATOR LAMB: I just bring that up because I think that is your intent, but I'm not sure...

SPEAKER BAACK: It is.

SENATOR LAMB: ...it is spelled out specifically here.
