PRESIDENT MOUL: Please record, Mr. Clerk. The question is, shall the house go under call? All in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays, to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. All members shall return to their seats. All unauthorized people should leave the floor and members should record their presence. Please record your presence, Senator Haberman, Senator Pirsch, Senator Hillman, and we're also looking for Senator Carson Rogers. We are still looking for Senator Hillman, Senator Pirsch and Senator Rogers. Senator Beyer, would you like to authorize call in votes? We will have call in votes.

CLERK: Senator Lamb voting yes. Senator Rogers voting yes. Senator Wesely voting no. Senator Pirsch voting yes. Senator Lynch voting yes. Senator Moore voting yes. Senator Beutler changing from yes to no. Senator Baack voting yes.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 8 nays, Madam President, on the motion to advance LB 62.
