SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 98 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, things for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do, thank you. Your Committee on Government, Military and Veterans Affairs, whose Chair is Senator Conway, reports LB 17 as advanced to General File with committee amendments attached; LB 20, General File with committee amendments attached; and LB 32, General File with committee amendments attached. (See pages 421-22 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Elmer, as Chair of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Committee will meet tomorrow morning, at eight-thirty, in Room 2102. Intergovernmental Committee, tomorrow morning at eight-thirty in Room 2102. That's offered by Senator Elmer. That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll now proceed to General File with LB 82.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 82 was a bill introduced by Senator Warner. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10 of this year, referred to the Revenue Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending by the Revenue Committee. (Revenue Committee amendments can be found on page 410 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will, are you going to handle those amendments?

SENATOR WILL: Yes, I'll handle the committee amendments. Senator Hall, the Chairman of the Revenue Committee, and Senator Heifner, the Vice-Chair, aren't here right now. LB 82 is a bill that Senator Warner brought to us. The committee amendment should be noncontroversial, it simply adds an operative date of October 1, 1991. I think it probably would be appropriate just to adopt that, and then have Senator Warner address the substance of the bill.
