SENATOR LAMB: A call of the house has been requested. All those in favor please vote aye. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR LAMB: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. All senators report to the floor and record your presence. Senator Morrissey, we're looking for Senator Morrissey. Senator Baack, for what purpose do you rise?

SPEAKER BAACK: Let's just have a roll call vote in regular order, please.

SENATOR LAMB: Roll call vote in regular order has been requested. Please call the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Took roll call vote. See page 523 of the Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to refer.

SENATOR LAMB: The motion fails. Item 6, Mr. Clerk. Raise the call

CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill on General File this morning, LB 88. The bill has been discussed by the Legislature on two occasions. I have pending, Mr. President, an amendment or the second portion of an amendment as offered by Senator Kristensen. The first portion was adopted by the body last Friday, February 1. Senator, I now have your second half of AM102. You'll find AM102 in your bill books, Mr. President. (Second Kristensen amendment appears on pages 523-27 of the Legislative Journal.)
