SENATOR WARNER: Is there further discussion? Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members, I would like to endorse this proposal by Senator Conway. Charlene Hirsch and her husband, Loren, are neighbors of mine, live about five miles from us, are very active in community affairs, have a business also in Broken Bow. Char, as she is called, is active in promotion of the area and also statewide. I think this is an excellent choice and I am pleased that the committee has brought this name forward.

SENATOR WARNER: Seeing no further discussion, Senator Conway, do you wish to close? Senator Conway passes. The motion is the adoption of the Government, Military, and Veterans Affairs Committee confirmation report. Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Clerk, record.
