

state senator needs and doesn't now get, I can't see it. In fact, George is quite right, if you call up an administrative agency now and give them notice that you're interested in their rules and regs, they will send them to you as is. They send them on a regular basis to people who identify themselves as people who care about the rules and regs and they will put you on their mailing list, just like we do the Legislative Update. But whether we're interested or not, they're going to send these documents that are required in the bill to us. We're not that lazy and, if we are, we shouldn't be. A little diligence is enough. This amendment is unnecessary because the bill is unnecessary. And all it is is a make-work project for people who won't get off their duff and call the administrative agency and say, look, your agency does work that our committee cares about, send us over your proposed rules and regs and have the staff go through it. If you want to short-circuit the process, do it that way, otherwise you're just going to have a bigger pile of papers that somebody doesn't look through and you don't need it.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you, Senator Landis. Senator Wesely, on the amendment? On the bill. Senator Beutler, on the amendment? Senator Coordsen, on the amendment? Would you care to close on the amendment, Senator Coordsen?

SENATOR COORDSEN: Goodness, this is so exciting I'm even turned off this morning but not by the issue. Senator Landis addressed the amendment and, quite frankly, Senator Landis is right, if we were diligent and if we were concerned and if we really cared and if we were interested in our legislation after we adjourn sine die and went home during the interim. He is right. How many of us do this? How many of the committees ask for notice of hearings? They're public knowledge. They're printed. How many of us pay any attention? LB 22 is an unnecessary bill that's necessary to jolt us into doing what we should be doing without it to provide a system, the amendment that we're talking about, I'm only talking about the bill because Senator Landis addressed it. I think it provides a system of putting the screws to us just a little bit to ensure that we do our job. I move the adoption of the amendment.
