LB 239.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 239 advances. LB 122, introduced by Senator Rogers.

CLERK: LB 122, Mr. President, introduced by Senator Rogers. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10, referred to Government, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Rogers.

SENATOR ROGERS: While I'm looking in my book, Mr. Speaker and members, if you will open up to your bill, 122, all this does is allows a county hospital board to have two members from a city. Now we've run into some problems in my district where sometimes it's hard to even get one board member to serve on the county board and all this does is increase that number from one board member to two board members. I move for advancement if there are no questions, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BAACK: Are there any...is there any discussion on the bill? I don't see any. Senator Rogers, do you want to close?

SENATOR ROGERS: Waive closing.

SPEAKER BAACK: He waives closing. We will now proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 122. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 122.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 122 is advanced. Do you have things for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Your Committee on Transportation, whose Chair is Senator Kristensen, reports LB 133 to General File; LB 286 to General File with committee amendments attached; LB 336 and LB 420, all signed by Senator Kristensen. (See pages 553-54 of the Legislative Journal.)
