PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Seeing no one else wishing to speak on the issue, do you have a closing statement, Senator Cudaback? Closing statement is waived. We will proceed to vote on the motion to advance LB 113. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is approved and LB 113 is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The next bill, Madam President, is LB 296. It was introduced by Senators Beyer and Hartnett. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time on January 15th, it was referred to the Transportation Committee. They report the bill to General File with committee amendments, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you. Senator Kristensen, do you have the committee amendments?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President, yes, I do, and similar to Senator Conway, the only committee amendment at this point was the adding of the emergency clause. This is a bill that will increase the additional fees that are collected by a county for the registration of motor vehicles of nonresidents. This is an effort to start to begin to collect the money sooner and thus collect more money, more revenue for the State of Nebraska. With that, I would urge the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Does anyone wish to speak on the motion to adopt the committee amendment? Seeing none, do you waive closing? Closing is waived. We will proceed to vote on the motion to adopt the committee amendment to add the emergency clause. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
