

warning to minors fine, the pregnancy poster and any other information that the commission deems important in the area of liquor. That would be like pamphlets, publications and retailer lists and so on. And then in addition to that the commission would be required to provide these materials to licensees without any additional costs where right now they are charging for some of these things, and for nonlicensees, only at a reasonable cost of publication. And the background on this is the fact that over the years we've heard from retailers and wholesalers about the lack of information that they have received from the Liquor Control Commission. LB 202 addresses that problem and it will go a long way toward keeping all licensees abreast of changes in the law which affect their operations. The fiscal note is for \$5,000. It is for one year only as a process of getting everything put together and increased costs of increasing the numbers of the publications and so on that they are going to be distributing.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Smith. Is there anyone who wishes to discuss this bill? Ah, Senator Morrissey.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Yes, thank you, Mr. Speaker. Senator Smith, did they give in testimony any idea of what the reasonable fee would be for nondealers?

SENATOR SMITH: Senator Morrissey, what they are saying is that it would not exceed the costs of producing the materials. So it can only be costs. A reasonable fee is just cost.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Fine. We're increasing the fee paid by all applicants from \$25 to \$30.

SENATOR SMITH: Right, right, \$5.00, uh-huh.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Now, to me, some of my folks down there seem to think that is to cover the fee of what they are now getting for free, or what the laws...they've been paying for this information before. Now they are going to get it for free, but their license is going to go up five bucks.

SENATOR SMITH: If the licensee desires to receive an updated law book, they have to pay \$15.00 for that and they have to make a request to do that so, see, they get one when they first get their license but then there is none after that, and in order to keep current with everything that is taking place, they have to
