

February 7, 1991 LB 247, 330

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Senator Ashford, on the bill.

SENATOR ASHFORD: The bill, itself, Mr. Speaker and members, simply adds two members to the five-member commission and requires that one member be a resident of or a...the way the amendment reads is that they must either own or operate a business or property within a landmark heritage district. And all that does...all this amendment does is require that one of the two new members be a business or representative of a business in a landmark heritage district. With that, I would move the amendment...the bill, unless there is some other comment on it.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there any discussion on the bill? Seeing none, Senator Ashford, do you wish to close? He waives closing. We will now proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 247. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 247.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 247 is advanced. We will now proceed to LB 330.

CLERK: LB 330, Mr. President, was a bill introduced by Senator Morrissey. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 16, referred to Urban Affairs, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Morrissey, on the bill.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members, as the Clerk stated, LB 330 would give cities of the first class, second class and villages the ability to control their enforcement on weeds and litter. It's a problem we've had specifically in Falls City, Nebraska, in my district. LB 330 would amend Section 16-230, governing cities of the first class and Section 17-563, governing cities of the second class and villages, to change provisions relating to the removal of weeds and litter. LB 330 would allow municipalities be more effective in the regulation of the weeds and litter in response to the increasing number of citizen complaints that my district and I'm sure towns and cities in your districts have been receiving in
