

February 8, 1991 LB 128, 354

PRESIDENT MOUL: Committee amendments are adopted. Senator Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Thank you, Madam President. Senator Hartnett, I believe, aptly described the bill. This simply provides for a \$10 per day late fee for filing SID statements, up to a maximum of \$300. And the reason for the bill is in order to provide to the general public, home buyers and others interested in purchasing property in SIDs, updated information on the SIDs in which the property is located. And that's basically it. There was some concerns about total fines, and Senator Hartnett's amendment takes care of that. So, with that, I would urge the advancement of the bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Ashford. Does anyone wish to speak on this bill? Seeing none, do you have a closing statement?

SENATOR ASHFORD: No closing, thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Closing is waived. We will proceed to vote on the motion to advance LB 128. All those in favor please vote aye, all those opposed please vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to advance LB 128.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is approved, and LB 128 is advanced. The Speaker has advised me that we will pass over LB 68 and proceed with LB 354. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 354 was a bill introduced by Senator Hall, Senator Hartnett and Senator Will. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 16 of this year. It was referred to the General Affairs Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending by the General Affairs Committee, chaired by Senator Smith. Those amendments are now before us.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Recognize Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: The Standing Committee amendment to LB 354 simply clarifies the bill. It strikes the original Section 1 and inserts Section 53-179 which provides for liquor to be sold
