of the arguments that are given by Senator Chambers and Senator Beutler fit like a glove on these other sports and I would urge this body to adopt the amendment. Thank you, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Haberman. Do we have anyone wishing to speak on the amendment to the amendment? I will recognize Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Haberman, I want it made clear that I'm as serious as a heart attack on this bill and I'm concerned for the players and I'm not joking. Now, I wanted to ask you a question. Are you jesting with your amendment or if it's adopted, you would then see where the bill has merit? Yes, you're jesting.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Yes, I would say that it has merit.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would you support the bill?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Let me ask you for a substitute then, because if you name some sports and we're not in a position to determine how many hours are in all of them, would you be willing to...and can you get the amendment that Senator Beutler and I co-sponsored so that you will see what I'm going to say. The time spent by University of Nebraska Lincoln, we would say athletes on athletic program activities and not give a laundry list. Would you be willing to have your amendment that you think is necessary, the one that Senator Beutler and I are co-sponsoring, apply to all the athletes in athletic programs and, by putting it in that form, a determination can be made as to those where an undue amount of time is taken?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Who is going to determine if an undue amount of time is taken?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The ones who will make the determination with reference to if it was just the football players in the football program and I will tell you who those people would be, based on the amendment. The University of Nebraska, acting in conjunction with the NCAA and other schools, it's saying that this is a serious area of concern and attention should be given to reducing the time demands on the athletes.
