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Nebraska-Lincoln would be working in concert with the NCAA to immediately begin the process of seriously reducing the time spent by college athletes across the United States on athletic activities. So it would also apply to more than just football, apply to all athletics, all colleges.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Will. Does anyone wish to speak on the Will amendment to the amendment? Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Madam President, members of the body, a question of Senator Chambers, please.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Chambers, if this amendment is adopted, does it change the other requirements in your bill?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, it doesn't alter the bill. It gives a balance and a perspective, a context in which all of this is being considered. And, if this amendment is adopted, Senator Haberman, and the bill is passed, remember the other portions of the bill will not take effect until states having four other schools would act. This could be done immediately. It would be the sense of the Legislature saying what ought to be done. And, as Senator Beutler pointed out, if this is done in conjunction with other rules changes, then the rest of the bill would be rendered unnecessary. But I think they both need to be there operating in tandem. It's like the carrot and the stick, so to speak. If the carrot is adopted, by the NCAA and these schools, the stick will never come into play. The ultimate aim is to help the players, it's not to punish the schools, it's not to just browbeat the NCAA, although that doesn't bother me. The ultimate goal is to help the players. So this amendment will not alter the rest of the bill.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Thank you, Senator Chambers.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Does anyone else wish to speak on the Will amendment to the amendments? Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Madam President and members of the body, I have some problems with this amendment. Okay, Senator Will, would you be willing to yield? You said you were striking lines 7 and 8. How about on line 3, "the University of Nebraska at Lincoln"?
