CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the confirmation report.

SPEAKER BAACK: The confirmation report is adopted. We will now proceed to Select File and LB 125.

CLERK: Mr. President, first order of business on LB 125 are adoption of E & R amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will, on the E & R amendments.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 125.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have an amendment from Senator Elmer. Senator, I have your AM0108 with a note that you want to withdraw that one. Is that correct?

SENATOR ELMER: That is correct.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.
