SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm going to ask for a roll call vote and we can proceed and maybe he will get here by then.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We'll proceed with a roll call vote on the Chambers amendment to the amendment.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See page 626 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment to the amendment is adopted and we will now proceed to resume debate on the Elmer amendment. The call is raised. Senator Elmer.
