PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 9 passes. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 10 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 10 pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 650-51 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 10 passes. I will now recognize Speaker Baack.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Madam President and colleagues, just a short announcement about the election contest that's going to be decided by the Legislature next Tuesday. I just want to let you know that that will be the first thing on the agenda next Tuesday morning. There will be a motion presented by the Executive Board to the floor of the Legislature. Then we will talk about that. I want to do it the first thing up. I would encourage my colleagues to be here on time because I would like to get through that process that morning if we possibly can and make a decision one way or the other in this case. I do want to let you know that every member will be receiving both of the briefs that were submitted by the two attorneys. Every member will also receive a transcript of the hearing that we held where the testimony was taken by the committee and then there are a number of other documents, lots of pages of documents that if you want access to them, you can go to Patrick and they can make those available to you. We're not making everything available because it's eight, nine hundred pages long and I don't think that everything is necessary for every member. We're trying to make the things available that we think that you definitely should look at and to make your own decision in this case. So if there are any other questions, you can come to me and ask but that's going to be the first thing up Tuesday morning and we're going to try and deal with that at that time. Thank you.
