

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is to call the question. Do we have seconds? Okay, we will proceed to vote on the motion to call the question. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to call the question? Senator Ashford has requested a call of the house. We will have a machine vote. Those in favor please vote yes, those opposed please vote no. Please record, Mr. Clerk, on a motion to go under call.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call and we will accept call in votes. All members who are not excused please return to the Chamber and record their presence. Unauthorized personnel should leave the floor. Please check in.

CLERK: Senator Rod Johnson voting yes. Senator Haberman voting yes. Senator Lynch voting yes. Senator Beyer voting yes.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays, to cease debate, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have ceased debate. The motion is the Wehrbein motion to reconsider the Warner amendment. Okay, I will recognize Senator Wehrbein to close.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: A question, Madam President. Are we still waiting for some to come under call then, too? We have some to check ..I would like to have...

PRESIDENT MOUL: We can wait until everyone is here. Looking for Senator Chambers, Senator Elmer, Senator Pirsch, Senator Landis, Senator Withem.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I would like to have everyone here before I...we take the vote, but I would like to just simply to say that I think we needed to reconsider this. I think it has very serious implications and ramifications as we get into changing this law. Also think that we need to consider what...the possibility of what LB 262 may or may not be able to get up in this stage. I don't think...we don't want to ask...we don't want to act hastily in this case, so I would just ask you to reconsider this very seriously as we move into this change in
