issue both in Executive Committee as well as on the vote yesterday. That is, I guess, beyond us at this point. We have now a minority report that I feel should be in proper form that should leave those tracks, if you will, that it is case specific and that is why I am supporting the motion by Senator Warner.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hall. We'll now go to Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Mr. Speaker, Mr. President, members of the body, I have a question. We adopt Senator Warner's amendment and then we adopt the minority report and it's all over. Is that correct? Senator Byars would be seated, am I correct on that?

SPEAKER BAACK: That is my interpretation, yes.

SENATOR ROBINSON: I just wanted to make sure that was clear in my mind. I guess, I don't know, evidently I don't think like the rest of you people. I got a few problems. I've taken over a few new words, a red herring. There's a red herring around here, I want you to know that. I've been told there is a red herring and by hook or crook...Mr. Speaker, how many votes were that are not counted that were thrown out, 90 some now in the...down at Beatrice? What was that total? Could you give me that total?

SPEAKER BAACK: I think it is 95.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Ninety-five, okay. And my good friend Senator Conway used the hook or crook. I don't know if he was talking about those people by hook or crook they got to vote or not. I'm not just...and then he talked about the slick ballots, and I want to go back. You know, I talked yesterday about the...I spoke on the over 500 ballots and I think if we're consistent we have to take a look at those 95 votes. I don't know how you people that voted with me on the 500 votes could vote for this amendment because I don't think you're being consistent. To me, I don't look at those votes any different. Now I agree they should be looked at and there should be some that possibly should be thrown out. I think it is so easy that we get down here and we interact between each other but we forget about where we came from. And I think we ought to reject this amendment and then I think we should adopt the Landis amendment. Thank you.
