

February 21, 1991 LB 37, 95, 135, 147

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 95 passes. We are going to pass over LB 240 and proceed with LB 37E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 37E on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 37 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 749-50 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 41 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 37 passes with the emergency clause. LB 135.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 135 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 135 pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 750-51 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 135 passes. I now have introduction of some special guests to make. Seated in the south balcony today are 39 members of the Nebraska group of Financial Women's International. They are here from all over the State of Nebraska today and welcome to the Chambers. We'll now proceed with LB 147.
