SPEAKER BAACK: The motion fails. Do you have another motion on the desk, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do, Senator Crosby would move to bracket LB 404 until March 1, 1991.

SENATOR CROSBY: I withdraw that motion, Mr. Speaker. I withdraw the motion, Mr. Speaker. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
