

February 22, 1991 LB 81, 113, 117

PRESIDENT MOUL: The two appointments are confirmed. We will now proceed with Final Reading. Would all of the senators please return to their desks. Would the senators please return to their seats so we can proceed with Final Reading. Thank you, senators. We will now proceed with LB 81E.

CLERK: (Read LB 81 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 81 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 765 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 1 nay, 4 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 81 passes with the emergency clause. Proceed with LB 113.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 113 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 113 pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all cast your final vote? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 766 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 41 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 113 passes. Now recognize Speaker Baack.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Madam Chair and colleagues. I...we are going to pass over LB 69 right now because there is a motion on the bill, and the introducer, Senator Chambers, has not arrived yet. So we'll pass over LB 69 for right now.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Speaker Baack. We'll proceed with LB 117E.
