SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Pirsch withdraws the amendment. Mr. Clerk, anything else on the bill?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: I would remind all members then that we are under Final Reading. Would you all please return to your seats. Proceed to read LB 88, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 88 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 779 of the Legislative Journal.) 30 ayes, 16 nays, 2 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 88 passes. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record? Okay, what we will proceed to do now is we will go to Select File to the bills that have only E & R amendments or no amendments at all. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill on Select File, pursuant to your directions, is LB 233. Senator Will, I have E & R amendments, Senator.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 233.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on that bill, Senator.
