PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, Madam President and members of the body, this is the Appropriation bill for the bill that would change the membership on the Commission on Indian Affairs from 15 to 14 and would also increase the per diem paid to commission members and would take the commission out of the Department of Economic Development. And the fiscal note is really for increasing the duties of those who are already employed by the Department of Economic Development and the fiscal note is \$7,193 per year. So with that, I do have a list of per diems going around. In fact, I think they are just being copied right now. The question came up on the floor during the debate on this about how many boards and commissions have increased their per diems, what do they pay and, frankly, I just got on the floor, I haven't really looked at it myself, but it does indicate that there are some variations in per diems. With that, I would be happy to answer questions if I can.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Is there any debate on this issue? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Schimek?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I'll waive closing.
