SPEAKER BAACK: Is there anyone wishing to discuss the Landis-Beutler amendment? Seeing no one, Senator Landis, do you wish to close?

SENATOR LANDIS: I simply wish to close by telling the body that I scrupulously inquired of both the Insurance Department and of Senator Beutler as to whether or not there was any form of loophole in this mechanism, and where it came down, and Senator Beutler indicated that this was clearly on the side of the consumer, to give them greater protection to make sure that what they are being promised will be delivered, and that's why we're offering it at this point. I would urge its adoption.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard Senator Landis' closing. We will now proceed to vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Landis' amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 235, as amended, to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 235. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. LB 96.

CLERK: LB 96, Senator, the only amendments I have are E & R amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I'd move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 96.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 96. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no.
