SENATOR HEFNER: Senator Beutler, could you answer that. Will the fees be by weight or volume?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Pardon me? By weight or volume? By volume, Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Excuse me, I didn't hear you.

SENATOR BEUTLER: By volume, sir.

SENATOR HEFNER: By volume.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay. And then one last question. The premium on property and third party liability insurance, do we know what the cost of this insurance is going to be and if it's available?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Hefner, we do not, to my knowledge, at this point in time. And that's one of the reasons for this elaborate tier system and structuring of fees, because it may be that it's not available. In which case we'll have to rely upon the other liability elements to cover ourselves.

SENATOR HEFNER: But then the whole compact would share this liability.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Right, absolutely.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay. Okay, thank you, thank you for the information.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Madam Chair and members. I also want to rise to support this amendment, because I think it's something that we've been working on for many years.
